

POLICY NO. 7

GOODWILL

The Goodwill Committee is established in each area in order to receive information regarding members who may be celebrating, recuperating or sorrowing and to extend to Area members an appropriate gesture in accordance with the following guidelines:

- 1. Illness to members who are ill for more than two (2) weeks or hospitalized for one (1) week or more:
- 2. Congratulations in the event of a birth or adoption of a child to a member or spouse; or marriage of a member:
- 3. Condolences to Survivors in the event of the death of an immediate family or household member;
- 4. Family Benefit immediately upon notification of the death of an active member:
- 5. Non-Member and Retired Members extend appropriate gestures as directed by the Executive. Card of thanks, get-well, congratulations, condolences or token gifts of goodwill.

Definition of family members in relation to above No. 1 through 4:

Spouse, (to include common-law or same-sex partner) children, parents, siblings, parents-in-law, siblings-in-law, grandparents, grandparents-in-law, grandchildren, or other persons living in the household of the member.
